VACCINATIONS - what ones do I need and how often?

<u>CORE VACCINES</u>	
Rabies	One shot protects the dog for life. Vaccinate at 16 weeks or older.
Parvovirus (CPV-2) (These three are in one vaccination shot)	One vaccination at 16 weeks or older provides lifetime protection. Did you know Distemper vaccine alone lasts at the minimum of 15 years?
Distemper (CDV)	same as above
Adenovirus (CAV-2)	same as above

What does adverse effect mean?

The vaccine will produce any unexpected or dangerous reaction to the drug, could be sudden or over time.

NON-CORE VACCINES - These vaccinations are absolutely NOT needed!

- Bordetella (vaccinated)
 - Did you know that this vaccination possibly lasts 9 months and doesn't even cover the Bordetella agents?
 - Did you know that Kennel Cough is NOT a vaccinatable disease? So, don't ever get the Bordetella shot!
- Bordetella (intranasal) - So what about the intranasal one?
 - You can get this one annually but understand these are all very toxic in your dogs' body. It is administered up the nose. Same as above.
- Lyme Disease
 - This vaccine is ineffective and a very high-risk vaccine. Long term side effects may include lyme-like symptoms, rheumatoid arthritis and kidney disease.
 - Did you know that Lyme vaccinations for Humans was withdrawn due to high adverse effect risk?
 - So, if they won't give it to a human, do you really want to give it to your dog?
- Leptospirosis 4 way
 - This vaccine only covers 4 out of 200 types of lepto.
 - It has one of highest adverse reactions of any vaccine.
 - Side effects are often severe and some are fatal.
 - Vaccination does not protect against lepto in the urine which means vaccinated dogs can spread lepto to humans. How scary is that!!

Female	Starting at 16 weeks, to 20 weeks max Before the hormonal glands develop
Male	Starting at 16 weeks, to 20 weeks max Before the hormonal glands develop
